On the Water Umpiring

Following on from the success of "On the Water Umpiring" that was used successfully at the 2006 Marblehead Worlds in Fleetwood, the Race Committee intends to appoint Umpires as prescribed in MYA SSI 2.9b.

The umpiring will be undertaken in accordance with ISAF-RSD Addendum Q UMPIRED FLEET RACING FOR RADIO-CONTROLLED BOATS which is attached for your information. This procedure indicates the way that umpires will be paired with observers. Although the procedure is quite detailed you are advised to read the sections on advice to Competitors and advice to Observers.
