

Definitions

Club: A club in Good Standing.

Officer: An Executive Officer, a District Councillor, a Non - Executive Officer, or an Honorary Officer.

1. Categories of Honorary Officers

There are four categories of Honorary Officers

- 1 Patron
- 2 President
- 3 Vice-Presidents
- 4 Trustees

Of these, the President and Vice-Presidents shall be granted membership of the "Presidents' Club", a "Club" established and managed by Council.

2. Appointment of Honorary Officers

- 2.1 The Patron shall be a person who is invited to take up the position by Council. The position will be held for their lifetime or until they request it be relinquished.
- 2.2 The President shall be nominated by Council. The President shall be appointed annually at the AGM.
- 2.3 Vice Presidents shall be nominated by any Club to Council in recognition of outstanding services rendered to the MYA. Council will form a review panel chaired by the President to consider nominations. Council will then put forward no more than 2 names annually for appointment at the AGM. The position will be held for life.
- 2.4 There shall be two Trustees. Their nomination will be proposed by Council and submitted to the membership for approval at the AGM.

3. Voting Rights

The President and Trustees may attend Council meetings but do not have any voting rights. Other Honorary Officers do not have a right to attend Council Meetings unless requested by Council or a Club, Class or District Committee. They do not have any voting rights.

4. Presidents' Club

4.1 The President and Vice-Presidents while in office shall be granted membership of the Presidents' Club which shall be a Club established and managed by Council.

4.2 Members of the Presidents' Club do not need to pay annual MYA subscription fees.
