

MYA Six Metre Class Rule

Subject: Emergency Class Rule change

Pre-amble

A change to a definition in the Equipment Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (ERS) has created problems in understanding the 6 Metre class rules correctly. Clauses 4.1.4 and 4.1.5 correct this.

In addition an important omission in the class rules has been noticed. Clause 4.1.6 corrects this.

This emergency class rule change is made to retain the previous sense of the class rules and, therefore, means owners do not need to amend their boats if they complied fully with the class rules previously.

Add to Section 4. RIG

4.1.4 The word **spar** in bold shall read as the word spar underlined throughout these class rules.

4.1.5 Spar is defined as:

The main structural part(s) of the **rig** to, or from, which **sails** are attached and/or supported.

4.1.6 The following ERS rules shall not apply:

- (a) B.1.2 **Mast Lower Limit Mark.**
- (b) B.2 **Headsail Booms.**
