



Memorandum of Understanding Dated 12th August 2022

Between

The RYA

and

MYA Official Measurer for Radio & Free Sailing in the UK

Background

- Official Measurer's in the UK are appointed or recognised by the RYA who may delegate this responsibility. (Equipment Rules of Sailing, C.4.4)
- The RYA has delegated responsibility for the administration of radio and free sailing within the UK to the Model Yachting Association (MYA).
- The MYA seeks to regularise the training and appointment of measurer's for radio and free sailing classes in the UK for the future.

Agreement

To these ends the following is agreed from 31st July 2022:

- 1 The RYA delegates authority to the MYA to appoint or recognise, and terminate the appointment of, MYA Class Measurers for the radio and free sailing classes and shall recognise them as Official Measurers for radio and free sailing classes.
- 2 The RYA authorises the MYA to develop a sail measurement course. The Content of the course shall be approved by the Technical committee of the RYA.
- 3 To be appointed as a sail measurer of the MYA the person shall have completed the course as detailed above.
- 4 A Sail Measurer may be appointed by the MYA as a MYA Class Measurer for the other equipment of radio and free sailing classes.
- 5 A MYA Class Measurer shall comply with all requirements of the MYA, including Individual Affiliate MYA Membership, continuing qualification and re-appointment as a MYA Sail Measurer, training required for re-appointment, etc. Currently OM's require recertification every 4 years.
- 6 Existing MYA Class Measurers providing a satisfactory standard of performance may continue to practice until the 31st Dec 2023 under their existing MYA appointment, at which time their appointment shall terminate.
- 7 The MYA shall provide Liability insurance cover for MYA appointed Official Measurers.
