Based in Portland, and set up in memory of Olympic Gold medal winning sailor Andrew (Bart) Simpson, who was tragically killed in an Americas Cup training accident, ASSF is a very successful sailing charity, who through various programmes world wide, encourage the participation in sailing and deliver it to those not always fortunate enough to be able to take part.

Every year in September the Foundation hold a fund raising event in the form of a yacht race known as "Bart's Bash" This event is a global yacht race with boats of all types taking part at yacht clubs in many countries and thousands of pounds are donated/raised towards the foundation.
