

MYA SUPPLEMENTARY CLASS RULES

- 1 Except where specified otherwise in the **class rules** and Appendix 1, a boat shall display on her **mainsail** her class insignia and on all **sails** a sail number as in (2) in accordance with (3), (4) and (5) and RRS G1.2 (a) (*App E G1.4 (a)*).
- 2 Sail number
 - (a) The sail number shall be the last two digits of: the **hull** registration number, or the competitor's personal number, or the owner's personal number.
 - (b) A single digit sail number shall be preceded by a zero.
 - (c) When there is conflict between sail numbers, or when a sail number may be misread, the race committee shall require that the sail numbers of one or more boats be changed to numeric alternatives.
- 3 At MYA events **sails** shall comply with these rules, otherwise they shall comply with the rules applicable at the time of their initial **certification**.
- 4 Specifications

Dimension	Minimum	Maximum
Height of sail numbers	100 mm	110 mm
Spacing of adjacent sail numbers	20 mm	30 mm
Height of national letters	60 mm	70 mm
Spacing of adjacent national letters	13 mm	23 mm

- 5 Positioning
 - (a) Sail marks shall be positioned on both sides of the **sail**, with those on the starboard side uppermost, approximately horizontally, with no less than 40 mm vertical spacing between marks on opposite sides of the **sail** and there shall be space in front of the sail number for a prefix '1'.
 - (b) Symmetrical or reversed class insignia shall be on the **mainsail**, above a line perpendicular to the **luff** through the **three-quarter leech point**, and may be positioned back to back. Otherwise their vertical spacing shall be no less than 20 mm.
 - (c) The sail numbers on a **mainsail** shall be positioned below class insignia and above the line perpendicular to the **luff** through the **quarter leech point**.

(d) Where the size of the **sail** prevents compliance with the above rules they shall be amended as follows and in the following order of precedence:

- i) sail numbers may extend below the specified line;
- ii) vertical spacing may be reduced to no less than 20 mm
between sail numbers and/or
between national letters;
- iii) vertical spacing of sail numbers may be reduced to no less than 20 mm;
- iv) height of sail numbers on **headsails** shall be reduced to less than 90 mm,
but no less than 80 mm, or shall be omitted.
- v) height of sail numbers on **mainsails** shall be reduced as necessary.

APPENDIX 1 – Free Sailing Classes

1 The MYA Supplementary Class Rules apply only to **mainsails**.
