- 3 The closing date for entries is 6 pm, 20th August 2021. There shall be no limit to the number of entries. After that time late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organising authority and shall incur the additional late entry fee.

Entry fee:- £5 to be paid on the day or by post before 20th August 2021. Make cheques payable to the Watermead Model Boat Club.

- 4 The skippers briefing will be held at 13:45. The warning signal for the first race will be no earlier than 13.50 hours on Saturday.

During the event, no race shall start after 15.50 hours. Any heat will be abandoned if not completed before 16.00 hours.
- 5 Launching of boats will be from the fixed pontoons. The control area(s) and launching area(s) will be advised at the start of the event.
- 6 Courses to be sailed will be advised during the event.
- 7 The right of appeal is denied only to the extent that a boat may have its finishing place or score altered by an appeal but that its transfer to the subsequent heat is not affected.
- 8 Prizes will be awarded for 1st place.
- 9 There are facilities at the sports field a short distance from the lake.
