

RG65 Midland District Champion Skipper Trophy.

Deed of Gift.

Introduction.

With the recent increased interest shown in the RG65 class of racing yacht within the MYA Midland District it was decided by the Midland District Committee that we would support the class by creating a “Champion Skipper Trophy”

The trophy is a glass racing yacht mounted on a wooden base.



The trophy was donated to the MYA Midland District by Mr Gordon Sears in 2022, and it is to be awarded annually to the top placed Midland District skipper.

Rules.

To be eligible to win this trophy the skipper must be in good standing with the MYA, and they must be registered with an MYA Midland District club in the year of the event. Also, only boats currently registered with the class registrar and that are in compliance with the current edition of the RG65 rule are eligible.

The sailing competition will be an “Open” event which is run to an agreed format and hosted at one of the MYA Midland District registered clubs, the winner will be the highest placed Midland District skipper at that event. The trophy is not to go outside the district.

A roll of honour list is to be posted to the Midland District website, along with a copy of this Deed of Gift.

Any changes to this Deed of Gift can only be made by the MYA Midland District Committee at an AGM and as appropriate to support the RG65 class.
