### Notice of Race for the Mac McCulloch Trophy and IOM Midland District Champion Skipper R1 to be held at Two Islands RYC on Furzton Lake, Milton Keynes on 21<sup>st</sup> April 2024

#### 1. Event Schedule

Registration & preparation 08:30 – 09:30 Briefing approximately 09.45

Racing will commence shortly after completion of Briefing

No race will start after 16.00 hrs any race in progress at 16.30 hrs will be abandoned.

#### 2. Location – Lynmouth Crescent, Furzton, Milton Keynes, MK4 1JP

Note: This is the Two Islands 'Normal Sailing' site on the opposite side of the lake to the Premier Inn location.

#### 3. Entry Fees - Event entry fees are £10.00 payable on the day at Registration.

The Race Officer reserves the right to use Observers drawn from the competitors.

#### 5. Entry List, Sail Numbers and Frequency Allocation.

Competitors will be asked to adjust their Sail Numbers should clashes arise. Where possible this request will be made before the day of the event.

#### 6. Entry and Eligibility

Entry is open to all members of MYA affiliated Clubs sailing registered IOM class yachts.

Enter directly on-line via the MYA Racing Calendar.

Go to <https://mya-uk.org.uk/events>. Then find the event.

The final closing date for receipt of entries is midnight on Wednesday April 17<sup>th</sup> 2024.

Entries will be capped at 40 to ensure sailing in 3 Heats or less.

#### 8. Parking – Please park neatly in the car park at the Location Post Code, the car park is currently free to use: it is used by visiting members of the public. There are no facilities for overnight parking of Campervans and the like.

#### 9. Refreshments – Sadly, the club has no facilities for providing on-site refreshments, competitors should make their own provisions. There are several small shopping areas within a mile of the lake.

- 10. General Info** – Wooden launching platforms are used: depending on wind direction it may be necessary to operate from a non-paved area so competitors are advised to have sturdy non-slip footwear available.

Due to ongoing construction work there are no nearby toilets, the nearest facilities are now a potential 30 minute round trip from the sailing area. Racing will be scheduled to accommodate such activities.

Should there be examples of floating weed in the lake on the last day of entries entrants will be notified of any changes (Postponement or Cancellation)

- 11. Competitors with Disability** - Competitors that require any form of help or special requirements should, prior to entry, get in touch with the organiser to check if the club is able to help with the provision of any such special requirements. The onus is on the competitor to establish whether the available facilities are adequate before deciding to enter the event.
