### **MYA MD 2026 race calendar.**

Simon Richardson has been working on the Midland District 2026 draft calendar for a while, and we are hoping to get a full season of events in during the year. With that in mind it has been decided to combine both the IOM winter & summer series into one for the 2026 season because of the lack of clubs offering to host an event during the year. So, the proposed profile will hopefully be:

**4** off IOM Midland District Champion skipper & club events. The Mac Colyer Trophy, this is the IOM District trophy, & The Clive Hand Memorial Trophy, form the basis of the IOMMDCS&C series.

**5** off 6M Midland District Champion skipper events. (These are usually sailed at Bournville RS&MBC & Two Islands RYC) with the addition of Manor Park RSC offering to host one again in 2026.

It is hoped that we can get **4** DF95 district open events in during 2026, as these have proved to be fairly popular, and discussions are ongoing with some of our new dinghy-based clubs to see if they could host an event with race support if required. So far, we have three confirmed.

We have experimented with putting a race on a Friday and it proved that we can get 20+ boats out, so this could be an option for the venues that have a busy full sized race calendar at weekends.

M, there was no Open event Marblehead racing at club level during the year, and so the only M racing in the district will those events organised by the MYA.

That in effect gives us **15 separate event days** in our District during the year. Plus, obviously the MYA events such as Nationals and Ranking events.

This is slightly down from previous levels, and it is hoped that it will help reduce the amount of event clashes, host club's workload, and hopefully increases the level of skipper participation in the events.

There will be DF 65 & 95 TT series events, plus RG65 TT events in the district in 2025 and these are being arranged by their owners' associations.

Thanks to the Midland District club representatives who have helped with the calendar by offering to host these events, and we will make a draft available to view at the Midland District AGM.

The MYA midland district events dates will be on the MYA website calendar.



Finally, whilst talking about events in our district there is now a lot more mid-week club racing days happening and getting good levels of support. These do not appear on the MYA calendar so if you fancy visiting another club, please get in contact with their secretary first and make arrangement.
