



MYA Scottish District Notice of Race and Entry Form

2026 MYA Scottish District IOM Wooden Hull Championship Murdieston Dam, Greenock – Greenock Model Yacht and Power Boat Club

Saturday 2nd May 2026

- 1) **Event Schedule** – Saturday 2nd May 2026. Registration up to 10:15hr. Skippers Briefing at 10:45hr. No race will start before 11:00hr or after 16:30hr and any race in progress at 17:00hr will be abandoned.
- 2) **Location and parking** – Murdieston Dam, Greenock PA16 9AE. **Parking** is available on Murdieston Street. Parking will not be available at the Clubhouse other than for persons with a disability. On arrival, participants may bring their car up to the clubhouse to offload their gear but their car must be promptly returned to Murdieston Street. Anyone needing to park at the clubhouse or who require any other help should advise the Event Secretary of their specific requirements in advance of the event.
- 3) **Entry and Eligibility** – Entry is open to all MYA members. All boats shall comply with the IOM Class Rules and must have a hull primarily constructed from wood. Competitors shall be required to undertake to sail in accordance with the [RYA Sailing Charter](#).
 - a) Email your entry details to the Event Secretary (details below).
 - b) Entries will accepted from **12:00hr Monday 5th April 2026**.
 - c) The closing date for entries is **17:00hr Thursday 30th April 2026**.
 - d) No entries will be taken on the day.
 - e) **The MYA Scottish District Personal Medical Information form ([pdf](#)) ([Word](#)) must be completed by ALL competitors and ALL race team members. It shall be presented at registration and retained in tool boxes or on their person.**
- 4) **Entry Fee and refreshments** – **£10.00 payable in cash** at registration which will cover refreshments during the day and lunch.
- 5) **Sailing Instructions** – The event will be run under the current version of the [MYA Scottish District Event SSI's](#). The Race Committee reserves the right to use Observers drawn from the competitors.
- 6) **Measurement and Sail Numbers** – The race committee may direct that boats be check measured at any time during the event. All yachts to display their registered boat number or an MYA Personal Sail Number belonging to the competing skipper or to the boat owner. Where applicable, a valid boat registration certificate and a Personal Sail Number certificate shall be presented at registration.
- 7) **Facilities** – The Clubhouse and toilets will be open on the day of the event.
- 8) **Special requirements** – Skippers are advised of the following requirements / restrictions:
 - a) There could be restrictions on movement on the pathway along the bank to facilitate the health and safety of members of the public, the participants and the Race Team. Launching and retrieval of boats from the two platforms along the bank may also be restricted. Any restrictions applying will be communicated at the briefing.
 - b) In wet weather the grass bank at Murdieston Dam can be very slippery. Participants are advised to bring suitable footwear (sailing type wellies are not suitable).
