- 1) **Event Schedule:**
Saturday, 29th August – 2026 MYA Scottish District DF65 Championship – Registration up to 10:15hr. Skippers Briefing at 10:45hr. No race will start before 11:00hr. No race will start before 11:00hr or after 16:30hr and any race in progress at 17:00hr will be abandoned.
Sunday, 30th August – Greenock MY&PBC DF65 Open Regatta – Registration for those only doing Sunday up to 09:30hr. Skippers Briefing at 09:45hr. No race will start before 10:00hr. No race will start after 15:30hr and any race in progress at 16:00hr will be abandoned.
- 2) **Location and parking** – Murdieston Dam, Greenock PA16 9AE. Parking will not be available at the Clubhouse other than for persons with a disability. On arrival, participants may bring their car up to the clubhouse to offload their gear but their car must be promptly returned to Murdieston Street. Anyone needing to park at the clubhouse or who require any other help should advise the Event Secretary of their specific requirements in advance of the event.
- 3) **Entry and Eligibility** – Entry is open to **all MYA members for Saturday**. For Sunday, as it is an open event open to all. Competitors shall be required to undertake and sail in accordance with the [RYA Sailing Charter](#).
 - a) Email your entry details to the Event Secretary (details below).
 - b) Entries will open on **Monday, 22nd June 2026**.
 - c) The closing date for entries will be **17:00hr on Wednesday 26th August 2026**.
 - d) No entries will be taken on the day.
 - e) **The MYA Scottish District Personal Medical Information form ([pdf](#)) ([Word](#)) must be completed by ALL competitors and ALL race team members and retained in their tool boxes or on their person.**
- 4) **Entry Fee – £10 per day** payable in cash on registration. The entry fee includes lunch, plus tea and coffee at all other times during the day.
- 5) **Sailing Instructions** – The event will be run under the current version of the [MYA Scottish District Event SSI's](#). The Race Committee reserves the right to use Observers drawn from the competitors.
- 6) **Measurement and Sail Numbers** – Boats shall comply with the class rules. The race team may direct that boats be check measured at any time during the event. All boats shall display their registered sail number or a Personal Sail Number as allocated under the Personal Sail Number scheme operated by the MYA. **For Sunday**, entrants may use their chosen number but may be required to add a prefix in accordance with MYA regulations.
- 7) **Facilities** – The Clubhouse and toilets will be open on the day of the event.
- 8) **Special requirements** – Skippers are advised of the following requirements / restrictions:
 - a) There could be restrictions on movement on the pathway along the bank to facilitate the health and safety of members of the public, the participants and the Race Team. Launching and retrieval of boats from the two platforms along the bank may also be restricted. Any restrictions applying will be communicated at the briefing.
 - b) In wet weather the grass bank at Murdieston Dam can be very slippery. Participants are advised to bring suitable footwear (sailing type wellies are not suitable).
